### January 2

- a. The birth of Cain then Abel. Genesis 4:1-2
- b. Cain's no blood sacrifice (ref. Hebrews 9:22). Genesis 4:3
- c. Cain kills Abel. Genesis 4:8
- d. Cain marked, driven out & builds first city named Enoch. Genesis 4:11-17
- e. Adam and Eve have Seth. Genesis 4:25
- f. Adam dies at age 930. Genesis 5:5
- g. Methuselah (granddad of Noah) is born; lives to 969, oldest. Genesis 5:21
- h. Enoch walks with God (doesn't die). Genesis 5:24
- i. Noah is born. Genesis 5:28-29
- j. Methuselah means "When he is dead it (flood) shall be sent".
- k. After Noah is 500, he has Shem, Japheth, Ham. Genesis 5:32

### 3. Condemnation

- l. Noah found grace in the eyes of the Lord among wickedness. Genesis 6:1-8
- m. Believed Noah spends 120 years building the ark.
- n. Ark is 3 stories high, 450 feet long, 75 feet wide, 45 feet tall. Genesis 6:15
- o. Ark can hold 520 train box cars, biggest ship until 1880.
- p. Became Rule of Thumb to build ships until probably 1900's.
- q. God tells Noah earth will be destroyed by flood. Genesis 6:17

### January 3

- a. 7 of every clean and 2 of every unclean animal and bird. Genesis 7:2-3
- b. Noah was 600 years old (appr. 1656 years from Creation). Genesis 7:6
- c. Noah, wife, 3 sons and wives, 8 total saved. Genesis 7:7
- d. Rains 40 days and 40 nights. Genesis 7:12
- e. Inside ark for 370 days, rests on Mount Ararat.
- f. Ice Age probably after the flood.
- g. While the earth remains, seasons remain. Genesis 8:22
- h. Rainbow covenant (God's grace). Genesis 9:13
- i. Noah dies at age 950. Genesis 9:28
- j. Japheth's descendants – Gentiles-Germany-Russia-Greece. Genesis 10:2-5
- k. Ham's descendants – Gentiles-Canaan-Nimrod. Genesis 10:6-20
- l. Shem's descendants – Jews. Genesis 10:21-30

### January 4

#### 4. Confusion

- a. Nimrod builds Babel (Gate to God). Genesis 11:1-9
- b. Tower of Brick – All 1 language.
- c. God confuses language (Babel new meaning).  
Abram will be changed to Abraham.
- d. From Shem to Terah to Abram. Genesis 11:10-26
- e. Terah sons Abram (Sarai), Nahor (Milcah), Haran and his son Lot. Genesis 11:27-31
- f. From Ur to Haran. Genesis 11:31-32
- g. God's Sevenfold Promise to Abram at 75. Genesis 12:1-4
  - 1. I will make of you a great nation.
  - 2. I will bless you.
  - 3. I will make your name great.
  - 4. You will be a blessing
  - 5. I will bless those that bless you.
  - 6. I will curse those that curse you.
  - 7. In you all the families of earth will be blessed.

- h. Abram, Sarai, Lot, people, and livestock arrive in Canaan. Genesis 12:5-6
- i. Famine forces Abram to go to Egypt. Genesis 12:10
- j. Abram sins by saying Sarai is his sister: 7 consequences Genesis 12:11-20
  - 1. He grieves God.
  - 2. He weakens his own faith.
  - 3. He weakened the faith of Sarai.
  - 4. He became a poor testimony to nephew Lot.
  - 5. He caused Pharaoh to be afflicted.
  - 6. He picked up Hagar, the Egyptian handmaid.
  - 7. He provided a bad example for future son Isaac.
- k. Rich Abram and rich Lot separate. Lot goes toward Sodom. Genesis 13:1-18
- l. Lot captured in battle and Abram's 318 men bring Lot back. Genesis 14:1-16
- m. Melchizedek (High Priest? Christ? Shem?) blesses Abram. Genesis 14:17-27
- n. Four Firsts:
  - 1. First COMMUNION (bread and wine).
  - 2. First mention of HOLY CITY (Salem)
  - 3. First mention of PRIEST
  - 4. First example of TITHING.

### **January 5**

- a. Abram believes God for a son. Genesis 15:4
- b. The Lord COUNTED him RIGHTEOUS because of his FAITH. Genesis 15:6
- c. 400 years of slavery prophesied. Genesis 15:13
- d. Lord ratifies the covenant with a smoking firepot and torch. Genesis 15:17
- e. Sarai gives Hagar to Abram, 86, as a wife; Ishmael is born. Genesis 16:1-16
- f. 13 years later Lord (El Shaddai-God Almighty) appears. Genesis 17:1
- g. Abram becomes Abraham - means father of many nations. Genesis 17:5
- h. Each male must be circumcised then at 8 days old. Genesis 17:9-14
- i. Circumcision is a sign of God's covenant. Genesis 17:14
- j. Sarai name changed to Sarah meaning princess. Genesis 17:15
- k. Prophecy Abraham at 100 and Sarah at 90 will birth Isaac. Genesis 17:17-19

### **January 6**

- a. The Lord promises Sarah a son. Genesis 18:1-15
- b. The Lord agrees not to destroy Sodom for 10 righteous. Genesis 18:6-33
- c. 2 angels take Lot, wife, and 2 daughters out of Sodom. Genesis 19:1-16
- d. Lot's wife is turned into a pillar of salt for looking back at the fire. Genesis 19:17-16
- e. Both of Lot's daughters get him drunk and have sex with him. Genesis 19:30-35
- f. Sons are Moab (Moabites) and Ben-ammi (Ammonites). Genesis 19:36-38
- g. Abraham tells Abimelech Sarah is his sister. Genesis 20:1-17
- h. Isaac (covenant heir) is born to Sarah at age 90 and Abraham age 100. Genesis 21:1-7

### **January 7**

- a. Abraham sends Hagar and son Ishmael away. Genesis 21:8-21
- b. Abraham makes treaty with Abimelech at Beersheba. Genesis 21:22-34
- c. God tests Abraham's faith by telling him to sacrifice Isaac. Genesis 22:1-2
  - Mount Moriah believed to be Golgotha where Jesus dies.
- d. Abraham tells servants to stay; he and the boy will worship and return. Genesis 22:3-5
- e. Abraham raises his knife to kill Isaac. An angel stops him; a ram is provided. Genesis 22:8-13
- f. New name for God Jehovah-Jireh (the Lord will provide). Genesis 22:14
- g. Sarah dies at 127 on Hebron of Canaan. Genesis 23:1-2
- h. Abraham buys cave at Machpelah; Sarah is buried there. Genesis 23:3-20
- i. Abraham tells servant to find a wife from his relatives for Isaac. Genesis 24:1-9
- j. Servants prayer; show me the right girl at the well. Genesis 24:12-14
- k. Rebekah is the one. Genesis 24:15-24

1. Isaac 40 marries Rebekah.

Genesis 24:67

1. Abraham is a type of God the Father.

a. Abraham marries Keturah and Abraham's descendants.

b. Ishmael's descendants.

c. 2 nations in Rebekah, Esau (red & hairy) and Jacob.

Genesis 25:23

d. Isaac was 60 when the twins were born.

Genesis 25:26

e. At age 175, Abraham dies and is buried in the cave at Machpelah.
