- d. O God, we have heard it with our own ears – our ancestors have told us all you did... Psalm 44:1
- e. You are the one who gives us victory over our enemies: Psalm 44:7
- f. But for your sake we are killed every day; we are being slaughtered like sheep. Psalm 44:22
- g. I will recite a lovely poem about the king, my tongue is like the pen of a skillful poet. Psalm 45:1
- h. God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble. Psalm 46:1
- i. Be still, and know that I am God! I will be honored by every nation. Psalm 46:10

- d. The wicked think, “God isn’t watching us!” Psalm 10:11
- e. The helpless put their trust in you. You defend the orphans. Psalm 10:14
- f. But the Lord watches over those who fear him, those who rely on his unfailing love. Psalm 33:18
- g. I will shout for you and sing your praises, for you have ransomed me. Psalm 71:23
- h. Those who live in the shelter of the Most High find rest in the shadow of the Almighty. Psalm 91:1
- i. For he will rescue you from every trap and protect you from deadly disease. Psalm 91:3

- c. Exalt the Lord our God, and worship at his holy mountain in Jerusalem. Psalm 99:9
- d. Enter his gates with thanksgiving; go into his courts with praise. Psalm 100:4
- e. Let this be recorded for future generations, that people not yet born will praise God. Psalm 102:18
- f. To hear the groans of the prisoners, to release those condemned to die. Psalm 102:20
- g. They will perish, but you remain forever; they will wear out like old clothing. Psalm 102:26
- h. You are dressed in a robe of light. You stretch out the starry curtains of the heavens. Psalm 104:2
- i. You clothed the earth with floods of water, water that covered even the mountains. Psalm 104:6

- f. But the Lord sent his servant Moses, along with Aaron, whom he had chosen. Psalm 105:26
- g. Our ancestors in Egypt were not impressed by the Lord's miraculous deeds. Psalm 106:7
- h. The people in the camp were jealous of Moses and envious of Aaron. Psalm 106:16
- i. The people made a calf at Mt. Sinai; they bowed before an image made of gold. Psalm 106:19
