- a. Moses begs to go into the land; the Lord is angry; only allows him to look at it. Deuteronomy 3:21-29
- b. Moses tells Israel to obey God's decrees, regulations, and the Ten Commandments. Deuteronomy 4:1-14
- c. Moses tells them not to corrupt themselves with idols. Deuteronomy 4:15-20
- d. They made the Lord angry at Moses; he will die on east side; consuming fire. Deuteronomy 4:21-24
- e. After you have abandoned God, you'll be scattered, you will return to the Lord. Deuteronomy 4:25-31
- f. The Lord is the One and only God. He's over heaven and earth. Deuteronomy 4:32-40
- g. Reuben, Gad, & the ½ tribe of Manasseh each get a city of refuge. Deuteronomy 4:41-43
- h. Moses tells them the law. They conquered from Mt. Herman to Dead Sea east. Deuteronomy 4:44-49
- i. Moses goes over the Ten Commandments; keep for long & prosperous lives. Deuteronomy 5:1-33

March 14

- a. Love the Lord your God with all your heart, all your soul, & all your strength. Deuteronomy 6:1-7
- b. Wear Ten Commandments on hands & foreheads; phylacteries in Matthew 23:5. Deuteronomy 6:8
- c. When future children ask meaning of the laws, God brought us out of Egypt. Deuteronomy 6:20-25
- d. Don't marry foreigners who worship idols. Don't be unequally yoked. 2 Cor. 6:14 Deuteronomy 7:4
- e. Lord didn't choose you because you were many but because He loved you. Deuteronomy 7:7-8
- f. Keep these regulations and be blessed with children, health, & prosperity. Deuteronomy 7:12-15
- g. Destroy all the nations and do not be afraid of them. Deuteronomy 7:16-21
- h. The Lord will drive them away little by little or wild animals will multiply. Deuteronomy 7:22-26
- i. Remember and obey when you have eaten, praise the Lord for the good land. Deuteronomy 8:1-20
- j. Moses is still speaking. God gives the victory by His grace. Deuteronomy 9:1-6
- k. Remember you made the Lord angry with the golden calf at Mount Sinai. Deuteronomy 9:7-21
- l. Made the Lord angry at Taberah, Massah, Kibroth-hattaavah, & Kadesh-barnea. Deuteronomy 9:22-29

March 15

- a. Remember to put the second set of stone tablets in the Ark of the Covenant. Deuteronomy 10:1-5
- b. Fear, love, obey, and serve the Lord. Deuteronomy 10:12-19
- c. God is the only One worthy of your praise. Deuteronomy 10:21
- d. Obedience brings blessings of long life; early and late rains; plenty to eat. Deuteronomy 11:8-25
- e. Moses is giving them a choice between blessing and a curse. Deuteronomy 11:26-32
- f. Worship the Lord your God in His place, in His way, and enjoy His presence. Deuteronomy 12:1-33

March 16

- a. God will test you by prophets who dream with signs to worship other gods. Deuteronomy 13:1-5
- b. Everyone that say let's go worship other gods must be put to death. Deuteronomy 13:6-18
- c. You may eat these clean animals: ox, sheep, goat, deer, gazelle, etc. Deuteronomy 14:4-5
- d. You may not eat: camels, hares, pigs, vultures, falcon, buzzards, etc. Deuteronomy 14:6-21
- e. A tithe is 1/10; 1/10 of your crops must be set aside. Deuteronomy 14:22-23
- f. Can buy sacrifices if too far away to take them to the Lord's place. Deuteronomy 14:24-29
- g. Every 7 years debts are to be cancelled, poor; Christ paid our debt/rich in Him. Deuteronomy 15:1-11
- h. Every 7th year Hebrew slaves to be released or can stay by putting a hole in ear. Deuteronomy 15:12-18
- i. Eat firstborn animals as a sacrifice in the presence of the Lord. Bad ones at home. Deuteronomy 15:19-23
- j. Festivals of Unleavened Bread, Harvest, Shelters. Don't come emptyhanded. Deuteronomy 16:1-17

March 17

- a. Judges not to accept gifts (bribes), blinds eyes of the wise. Deuteronomy 16:18-22
- b. Takes 2-3 witnesses to put a person to death. Deuteronomy 17:6
- c. When you must have a king select the one God chooses. Deuteronomy 17:14-20
- d. The priests and Levites will eat from the special gifts given to the Lord. Deuteronomy 18:1-8
- e. You must be blameless before God; example: never sacrifice a child. Deuteronomy 18:9-14
- f. Listen to true prophets, not to a prophet whose prediction did not come true. Deuteronomy 18:15-22
- g. Cities of Refuge represents our refuge in Christ. Deuteronomy 19:1-13
- h. Judge by 2-3 witnesses, show no pity to the guilty even false accusers. Deuteronomy 19:14-21
- i. War regulations sent home: new house, new spouse, new vineyard, or afraid. Deuteronomy 20:1-20
- j. Cleansing for unsolved murder: elders wash hands & pray for forgiveness. Deuteronomy 21:1-9

March 18

- a. Marriage to a prisoner of war, if not pleased set free. Deuteronomy 21:1-14
- b. Man with 2 wives, oldest son gets larger inheritance, even if from an unloved wife. Deuteronomy 21:15-17
- c. Rebellious son to be stoned to death. Purge this evil. Christians purge our evil. Deuteronomy 21:21
- d. Body can't hang overnight "cursed is everyone that hangs on a tree"- Gal. 3:13 Deuteronomy 21:23
- e. Regulations for sexual purity. Adulterers to be stoned to death. John 8:1-11 Deuteronomy 22:13-30
- f. Illegitimate by birth the next 10 generations can't be used by Lord; Judah-David. Deuteronomy 23:2
- g. May eat grapes and heads of grain of your neighbors. Matthew 12:1 Deuteronomy 23:24-25
- h. Welfare system was to leave some on trees and in fields for the poor. Deuteronomy 24:19-22

March 19

- a. Give God the first of your earnings. Deuteronomy 26:1-2
- b. God's people are His special treasure and must obey His commands. Deuteronomy 26:16-19
- c. After crossing the Jordan River, build an altar at Mount Ebal. Deuteronomy 27:1-10
- d. Curses from Mount Ebal: cursed is anyone who...people reply "Amen". Deuteronomy 27:11-26
- e. Obey God's commandments; you'll blessed to be head not tail, top not bottom. Deuteronomy 28:1-14
- f. More curses. Deuteronomy 28:15-63
- g. When you don't obey the Lord, He will scatter you among the nations. (605 BC) Deuteronomy 28:64-68
