- a. The Covenant reviewed; obey, and prosper you and your future generations. Deuteronomy 29:2-15
- b. All the curses in this book will come down on the disobedient. Deuteronomy 29:20
- c. Secrets belong to God; we are accountable for what is revealed to us. Deuteronomy 29:29
- d. The scattered will be gathered. Happens twice: 538 BC and 1948 AD. Deuteronomy 30:3-5
- e. Command not too difficult for you and not beyond your reach. Deuteronomy 30:11-14
- f. Life and death set before you, choose life. Deuteronomy 30:15-20
- g. Moses is 120 years old, Joshua commissioned, be strong and courageous. Deuteronomy 31:1-8

- b. Let the tribe of Reuben live and not die out. Deuteronomy 33:6
- c. To Judah, give them strength to defend their cause, help against their enemies. Deuteronomy 33:7
- d. Bless the ministry of the Levites, hit their enemies where it hurts the most. Deuteronomy 33:11
- e. Benjamin is loved by the Lord and lives in safety beside him. Deuteronomy 33:12
- f. To Joseph (tribes of Manasseh and Ephraim) their land is blessed by the Lord. Deuteronomy 33:13
- g. Zebulon prosper in travels, Issachar prosper at home. Deuteronomy 33:18

- l. Scarlet (bright red) rope is to be hung to save Rehab's family for saving spies. Joshua 2:2-24

- b. Twelve chosen men bring a stone from the Jordan River for a memorial. Joshua 4:1-24
- c. Circumcision started again, and manna ended. Joshua 5:2-12
- d. Joshua meets the Commander of the Lord's army (Jesus). Joshua 5:13-15
- e. God gives them Jericho. Joshua 6:2
- f. March around Jericho 7 days, horns blow, people shout, walls of town collapse. Joshua 6:3-16
- g. Rahab and family spared. Joshua 6:23
- h. All the treasures belong to the Lord. Joshua 6:24
- i. Jericho curse: rebuilders oldest son dies, finisher loses youngest son. 1 Kings 16:34 Joshua 6:26
